- 2. What is adoption?

Adoption – leaving one's natural family and entering into the privileges and responsibilities of another

- Adoptive parents are real parents.
- The family that placed the child for adoption are 'birth parents' or 'biological parents.'
- The birth mother did not 'give up her child.' She made an adoption plan.
- Adoption can be domestic or international. The term 'international adoption' is preferable to 'foreign adoption.'
- Adoption is forever and adoptive parents have full rights under the law as parents.
- Children who are adopted are not unwanted children. Birth parents choose to place their child for adoption because they want what is best for the child.
- Adoption can be open, semi-open, or closed. Each designation describes the degree of ongoing communication between the birth parents and the adoptive parents.
- Adoption can be infant, foster care, relative adoption, or step-parent adoption.
- 3. What does the Bible say about adoption? (Look up adopted, adoption, inheritance, sons)
 - Moses, Esther, and Jesus were adopted
 - We are adopted as sons and daughters of God.
 - As adopted sons and daughters, we await a final inheritance in glory.

- 4. What are the Benefits of Adoption? (From Focus on the Family, Sanctity of Human Life Guide, 2012, p.18)
 - Almost without exception, birth mothers who choose an adoptive family for their baby later say it was the right decision.
 - Statistically, adoptive children have stronger self-esteem than children raised by single mothers.
 - Children in families without fathers are five times more likely to grow up in poverty.
 - Children in families without fathers are two or three times more likely to abuse drugs.
 - o 70% of long-term inmates grew up fatherless.
 - Girls without a father in the home are more likely to get pregnant before marriage.
 - o Adoption is a truly heroic act an act of love.
