**Grade/Category:** 9-12, GO Serve Women

**Title:** A Critique of Pro-Choice Slogans

**Objective:** Students are equipped to refute pro-choice slogans

**Bible Verse:** A soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger. Proverbs 15:1

**Supplies:**

Article, *Pro-choice Slogans: A Critique*, by Dr. Raymond J. Adamek

**Procedures:**

1. Name slogans used by pro-choice advocates
2. Read Adamek article and discuss.
3. In small groups, role-play a discussion of one of the five slogans.

**Vocabulary:** slogan, morality, pro-choice, religion, theology

**Extensions:**

1. Design a bumper sticker or a sign that refutes one of the five slogans reviewed.
2. Read and critique a piece written from a 'pro-choice' perspective.
