



## Pregnancy

**Grade/Category:** 6-8, GO Save Lives

**Title:** Pregnancy

**Objective:** Students will have accurate information regarding pregnancy, from conception through birth.

**Bible Verse:** On you was I cast from my birth, and from my mother's womb you have been my God.  
Psalm 22:10

**Supplies:**

1. Pregnancy Month-by-Month Worksheet, answer key, and graphics

**Procedures:**

1. Pass out worksheets.
2. Watch, "Infinite Possibilities: A Baby's First Months", National Right to Life [www.nrlc.org](http://www.nrlc.org)  
Students' record information in the chart as presented in the video.
3. From previous knowledge or quick internet search, have students fill in chart as much as they are able.
4. Using answer key, check and complete worksheets, and cut and paste pictures into correct spaces.

**Vocabulary:**

Uterus, nausea, trimester, antibodies

**Extensions:**

1. Draw lines or cut yarn to represent baby's growth in length; add flour to a scale to demonstrate baby's weight increase.
2. Read A Child is Born, Lennart Nilsson
3. Personal journal- How did your mother feel during her pregnancy with you? How old was she when you were born? Did you arrive early, late, on time? What was your weight/length at birth? Did you have hair at birth? Are there any ultrasounds images of you before birth?
4. Share models of fetal development.
